## RESOLUTION 2020-2

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF CEDARBURG, WISCONSIN

### **“A Resolution Declaring a State of Emergency in the Town of Cedarburg”**

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Cedarburg does hereby resolve as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedarburg (“Town”) is a political subdivision as a body corporate and politic within Ozaukee County, Wisconsin; and

**WHEREAS**, in December 2019, a novel strain of the coronavirus now named Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) was detected and has spread throughout many countries, including the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the World Health Organization has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; and the United States Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2020, the State of Wisconsin has declared the existence of a public health emergency, as defined in Sec. 323.02(16), Wis. Stats.; and

**WHEREAS**, the existence of confirmed cases of COVID-19 within Wisconsin constitutes a condition within the Town posing an imminent threat of a disaster within the meaning of Chapter 323 of the Wisconsin Statutes that could impair medical care, health protection, and other critical systems of Ozaukee County; and


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons within the Town of Cedarburg, that reasonable and prudent steps be taken to treat those infected with COVID-19 and to prevent, limit and contain the potential community spread of COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, declaring a state of emergency will facilitate and expedite the use of resources to protect persons from the impacts of the spread of COVID-19 while ensuring continuity of critical operations within the Town of Cedarburg.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, pursuant to Secs. 323.11 and 323.14 (4), Wis. Stats., and Secs. 36-4 of the Town Code of the Town of Cedarburg that the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg hereby declares that a state of emergency now exists within the Town of Cedarburg in light of the public health threat posed by COVID-19.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the period of emergency shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist for a period of ninety days or until modified by further declaration.
