RESOLUTION 2020-7

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF CEDARBURG, WISCONSIN

"A Resolution Extending the Declared State of Emergency in the Town of Cedarburg"

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Cedarburg does hereby resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg ("Town") is a political subdivision as a body corporate and politic within Ozaukee County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, in December 2019, a novel strain of the coronavirus now named Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) was detected and has spread throughout numerous countries, and the United States, including Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; and the United States Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the State of Wisconsin has declared the existence of a public health emergency, as defined in Sec. 323.02(16), Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, the Town Board adopted Resolution No. 2020-2 declaring the existence of a public health emergency, as defined in Sec. 323.02(16), Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Declaration in Resolution 2020-2 is set to expire on June 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the Emergency Declaration within the Town continue to exist and are projected to exist for the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg has been working to protect the community from the spread of COVID-19, and taking precautionary steps to minimize its impacts; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons within the Town of Cedarburg, that reasonable and prudent steps be taken to treat those infected with COVID-19 and to prevent, limit and contain the potential community spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, continuing the declared state of emergency will facilitate and expedite the use of resources to protect persons from the impacts of the spread of COVID-19 while ensuring continuity of critical operations within the Town of Cedarburg.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Secs. 323.11 and 323.14 (4), Wis. Stats., and Secs. 36-4 of the Town Code of the Town of Cedarburg that the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg hereby declares that a state of emergency continues to exist within the Town of Cedarburg due to the public health threat posed by the COVID-19 pandemic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the period of emergency shall be extended until October 31, 2020, unless otherwise revoked or further extended by Resolution.
