You are invited to attend a public involvement meeting being conducted by the Ozaukee County Highway Department to discuss the planned improvements to the County NN (Washington Ave) intersection with County Y (Granville Rd). The meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, September 21, 2021 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Cedarburg Town Hall**, located at 1293 Washington Avenue, Cedarburg, Wisconsin.

Ozaukee County is in the process of completing the preliminary design in coordination with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation as part of a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) project. Ozaukee County has retained GRAEF, a consulting engineering firm, to prepare plans for this project. The project consists of spot safety and operational improvements including installation of a new traffic signal, eliminating the east leg of W. Pleasant Valley Road at CTH NN, widening of the intersection to accommodate turn lanes, installing roadway lighting, and pavement marking and roadway signing upgrades. Construction is scheduled for 2023.

The meeting is intended to show the proposed improvements, provide information about the schedule and impacts to parcels along the projects. The meeting will be an open house format with project personnel from Ozaukee County and GRAEF available to answer individual questions.

The meeting facility is wheelchair accessible. Hearing impaired persons needing assistance may call the Wisconsin Telecommunication Relay System (dial 711). To allow time for arranging assistance, please call no later than three working days prior to the hearing.
