"A Resolution Authorizing the Transfer of Impact Fees Funds from the Special Revenue Account to the General Fund for Fire/EMS related expenses"

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Town Code 184-16 Public Facilities; Impact Fees, the Cedarburg Town Board is permitted to collect impact fees for residential property, and

WHEREAS, The Town has approved a 10-year shared services agreement with the City of Cedarburg regarding the provision of Fire & EMS services, and

WHEREAS, certain expenditures related to the Fire Department are part of the Town's Impact Fee Ordinance, and debt related to the construction of Fire Station No. 2 has been paid in full and a transfer of Impact fee funds to the General Fund will account for such expenses already paid, and

WHEREAS, these funds are held in the Special Revenue account under impact Fees, and

WHEREAS, \$125,219.81 or an amount greater than that which represents the current balance of Impact Fee funds identified for the Fire Department will be moved to the General Fund account which the Town is using for costs associated with the shared services agreement with the City of Cedarburg, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of Cedarburg does hereby approve the Town Treasurer to move the impact fee funds to the General Fund.
