## **Town of Cedarburg Announces Launch of a Capital Fundraising Campaign for the Korb Sports Complex**

The Korb Sports Complex in the Town of Cedarburg has been the home to Cedarburg Little League and other Town recreation programs since the complex opened in 2020. The Town committed \$1.6 million and received generous donations from other members of the greater Cedarburg area to make the Korb Sports Complex possible. In addition to the 1,000+ children the Town has in recreation programming annually, the Korb Sports Complex has received community rental use by numerous local youth organizations such as the Cedarburg Mercs, Bigler Sports, Jr. Chinooks, Velocity Softball, Washington County Homeschool Association, Athlete Performance, I AM Volleyball Club, and more.

In order to better serve the growing user base of the complex, the Town is seeking to raise funds to make additional infrastructure improvements. The primary improvement seeks funding for a pavilion/restroom building that would also house a concession stand that can be rented out for birthday parties and other smaller events while providing shaded areas. Along with the pavilion/restroom facility, the Town is seeking funds for the paving of the gravel parking areas and south driveway, electrical service to the four north little league fields for the use of electric pitching machines, turf for the hitting tunnels, and a separate open-air pavilion located between the Little League Fields and T-Ball Fields.

The fundraising goal is just over \$1.3 million to complete all of the projects. As funds are raised, the Town will seek bids to complete the work at the direction of the Town Board. These projects would provide: better access to the complex while decreasing maintenance of the parking areas; permanent ADA compliant restroom facilities; shade for participants and spectators; concessions facilities; and a rentable open-air space with access to a kitchen to host seasonal birthday parties, graduation parties or other gatherings and flexibility for youth programming.

A rendering of the pavilion/restroom building was provided to the Town by Design 2 Construct as an in-kind donation.
